Welcome back to the Lisson Arches newsletter, keeping you up to date with what's happening with the development.

Since the last newsletter, there has been a lot of work happening on site. The frame to building is now complete and we are well on our way to completing the scaffold around the building.

This will enable us to start work on the external walls. Inside the building, the mechanical and electrical installation is underway and we have also begun to install flooring in some areas. Looking ahead, we are planning to start fitting the new windows from this month.
