

WHAT'S NEW AT ASHBRIDGE, ASHMILL AND COSWAY

Welcome back to the Ashbridge, Ashmill and Cosway newsletter, keeping you up to date with what's happening with the development in and around your neighbourhood.

Since the last newsletter, Osborne has now formally been appointed to undertake the main construction work. We are currently working on the site preparation and early enabling activities, as well as demolishing the ground floor slab and the existing basement at Ashbridge Street.

Following completion of the demolition, the focus will be on installing the foundations and the new structure at basement and ground floor level.

At Cosway Street we have completed demolition and are now preparing the piling mat in advance of piling commencing. The piling mat will be made of demolition material that has been recycled.

Finally, ground preparation works have begun at Ashmill Street, work will then begin to install the foundation.

WHAT IS A PILING MAT?

A piling mat is a temporary working platform designed to provide a reliable and stable surface on which piling rigs and other ground treatment machinery can operate.
