Safe, cherished and green streets help build healthy communities by improving both mental and physical health, contributing to the pride of an area and contributing to a strong local economy.



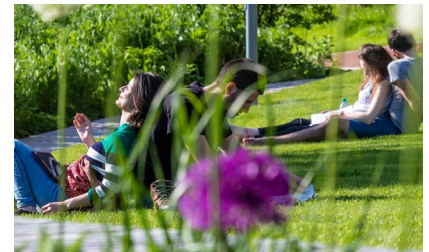

Create a flexible and inclusive outdoor space which responds to the needs of the community to provide necessary facilities and restful spaces.



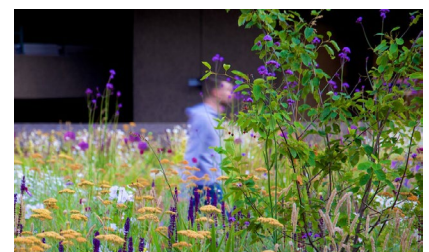
HARDWORKING & PLAYFUL PUBLIC REALM

Improved and sustainable streets can greatly contribute to the natural environment through increased greening & biodiversity, rainwater treatment and improvements to air quality.



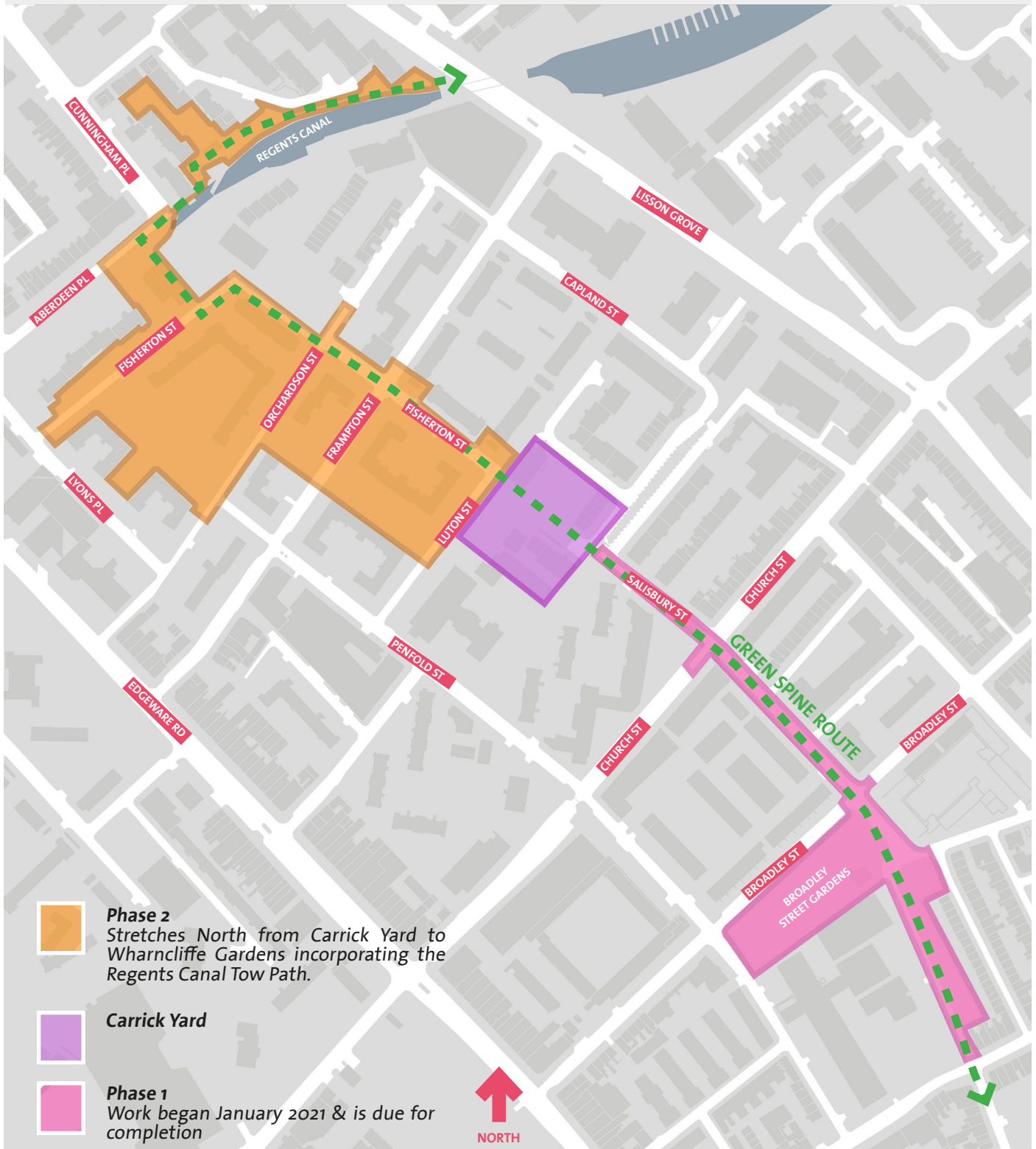
GREEN SPINE PHASE 2

Phase 2: Connection with Phase 1

The map below locates Green Spine Phase 1, the Carrick Yard development and the area included as part of Green Spine Phase 2. It is intended that Phase 2 will connect with Phase 1 to extend the pedestrian-friendly route with new green spaces and recreational areas. Through the Green Spine everyone will have access to nature right on their doorstep bringing positive new health and well-being benefits. Improving access and wayfinding, air quality and increasing local biodiversity.

The Phase 2 area refers to external landscape & public realm areas and not buildings.
