### WHAT'S NEW IN YOUR AREA?

**W**elcome back to the Lisson Arches newsletter, keeping you up to date with what's happening with the development in and around your neighbourhood.

Since the last newsletter, the reinforced concrete building structure is progressing at pace. The lower levels and the ground storey of the residential tower development are now complete, and the tower is rising above the hoarding level. The basement areas for the Enterprise Building are nearly complete and progress has been made on the concrete slab, which will form the ground floor base.

Once the building structure progresses to the third floor, scaffolding will be erected for the exterior brick cladding to be installed. Interior services will also commence with installation following the progress of the reinforced concrete structure.

The traffic restriction in Bernhardt Crescent will be removed once the Enterprise Building structure reaches the upper levels, from here the site boundary can be moved in along the length of the road. The team has already made modifications by installing protective barriers next to the site offices for the new boundary line.

#### AN UPDATE ON THE GENERATOR

We would like to thank the community for their feedback on the location of the generator. We are pleased to inform you that the generator was successfully relocated from its previous location near Chequers House, to the other side of the site near the welfare cabins, we have also added additional screening to reduce the noise.
