A progress picture of Luton Street

Welcome back to the Luton and Fisherton Street newsletter, keeping you up to date with what's happening with the development. The main structure, including the three town houses on Fisherton Street, is now complete. The team is now focused on the completion of the roof coverings, brick work and the fit-out of the new homes including the mechanical and electrical equipment to provide sustainable heat, hot water and power. As you will have seen, the first tower crane was successfully dismantled in July, which has allowed us to begin the internal finishes in the Sport Hall.

We are currently seeking the contract for the landscaping works, which will start in early 2022, this is a key part of the development as it will linkin with the Green Spine.
